Enhanced School-based Learning Activities Support Grant (2026-27)

Issued on 9th Sep 2025

To streamline schools' administrative work and enhance the flexibility, efficiency and synergy in the use of grants, the Education Bureau will integrate the School-based After-school Learning and Support Programmes (SALSP) and the Student Activities Support Grant (SASG) into the Enhanced School-based Learning Activities Support Grant (ESLASG) starting from the 2026/27 school year. The new grant will continue to support students with financial needs in participating in diversified out-of-classroom learning activities. Details of the subsidy are as follows:

Scope of activities	Category	Examples
	(1) Activities / Competitions for broadening students' learning experiences outside the classroom	Arts and cultural activities / Sports / Visits / Outdoor activities
	(2) Activities that broaden students' understanding of the community and promote their personal growth	Community services / Self-confidence building / Leadership training / Social and communication skills training / Mental health activities
	(3) Activities that enhance students' learning	Tutorial services / Study skills training / Language training
Eligible Students	All S.1-S.6 students who have participated in extracurricular activities organized or recognized by school and meet one of the following criteria may apply for the subsidy. (1) Students receiving "Comprehensive Social Security Assistance" (CSSA). (2) Students receiving full grant under the School Textbook Assistance Scheme (STAS-Full). If parents do not meet the above eligibility criteria but face financial hardship, they may explain their circumstances to the school, e.g. receiving a half grant under the School Textbook Assistance Scheme (STAS-Half), unemployment, or the loss of the family's primary income provider. The school will consider applications on a case-by-case basis.	
Amount of subsidy	1) It will be adjusted with reference to the financial condition of the family. 2) It will be adjusted with reference to the cost of each activity and the number of participants. 3) The exact amount of funding for each activity will be announced later. The school will flexibly approve the subsidy, but the total amount of subsidy available to students for the same activity <u>will not exceed the fee required for the activity.</u>

Application	(1) Download the relevant form on school website or obtain it from school office. (2) Submit the completed application form with signature of the teacher responsible and the attendance proof (if any). If items were not purchased through the school, attach the original invoice or receipt and return everything to the school office. (3) Appropriation Letter will be given by the school to the successful applicant after assessment. (4) Successful applicant shall return the slip of the Appropriation Letter to school office before the designated date. (5) Students collect the cheque given by the school and sign for acknowledgement.
