Forty years is a long time. SALEM-Immanuel Lutheran College (ILC) started with 8 classes of pupils and about a dozen teachers when it first opened in Tai Po in 1983. During the following 4 decades, our school has undergone much development and numerous changes. At its peak, ILC had over 1,200 students, and this year we have 25 classes with a student population of a little under 800 together with a faculty and staff of nearly 100.

Many things have changed over the past 40 years, yet there are many things that have remained unaltered. ILC continues to be a school using English as its medium of instruction (except for Chinese language and related subjects). It also continues to be a place where the Christian religion is taught and practised. Today, ILC still prides itself on providing the best academic education to young people in the community. Our mission and core values have remained unchanged since ILC opened its doors in Tai Po 40 years ago.

We will not forsake or give up our mission and vision no matter what challenges lie ahead.

Principal's Words

SALEM-Immanuel Lutheran College (ILC) was founded 40 years ago by American missionaries in Tai Po, Hong Kong. As part of the 40th anniversary celebrations, the "Family of ILC Teachers" (F.I.T.) was established in November 2023 during the Open Day. This initiative aims to perpetuate a culture of caring and love, fostering a sense of community among all teachers, both former and current. The enthusiasm and dedication of our teachers are the hallmarks of ILC, and during the Staff Retreat in August 2024, members of F.I.T. united to reaffirm our mission of serving our students.

The bond within this "big family" is strengthened by the frequent visits of alumni during Open Days. 

RoboMaster Competition




During the competition, the engineering RoboMaster is designed and programmed to use its robotic arm to retrieve ammunition bottles from the resource island.

Values of the Discipline and Guidance Committee

We (DGC) believe that positive guidance and discipline can promote students' self-control, teach them responsibility and guide them to make thoughtful choices, seek solutions to problems and assume responsibility for the consequences of their choices. And the Prefect team are the facilitator to promote our values.

Interview with the Prefect Leaders across Three Generations

Date: June 2024 Interviewer: Ms. Yuen Ming Wai Interviewees:

- (1) Ms. Coco Cheung was the Prefect Captain during her secondary life in ILC. She is now our Physics teacher.
- (2) Ms. Yeung Yin Hing was the Head Prefect when she studied at ILC, and she is now our Chinese teacher.
- (3) 5B Chung Cheuk Wing was the Head Prefect in 2023-2024.

Looking back on the experience as the Head Prefect or Prefect Captain in ILC, what important values were established?

Ms. Co Co Cheung F-O-C-U-S

F stands for Faithfulness in small matters: Being loyal and committed to the smallest details of the tasks.

O stands for On-time: "Being punctual is being late" – it's always important to have a sense of time and avoid tardiness.

C stands for Constructive discipline: Using disciplinary methods that focus on character building rather than embarrassing students.

U stands for Undertaking trust-building: Establishing a foundation of mutual trust as a fundamental aspect of discipline.

S stands for Serving heart: Not to be served but to serve.

Ms. Yeung Yin Hing "Without rectifying oneself, how can one rectify others!" This was the motto given to us by Mr. Tam. I was often tempted by the lax behaviour of my peers, but as soon as I thought about my own role and identity, I knew I had to uphold my principles.

5B Chung Cheuk Wing Teamwork and mutual support are the values I have learned, which can make members feel secure and confident. Rather than waiting for teammates to seek help, I feel the need to regularly check in, identify areas where they might be facing difficulties, and help in advance.

I really agree with Miss Yeung to set a good example for my peers by demonstrating the behaviours which follow the principles. Besides, it is crucial to enforce the school rules consistently to every student.

In recent years, the mental well-being of young people seems to be fragile. How can we strike a balance between safeguarding the mental health of adolescents and enforcing discipline?

Ms. Co Co Cheung To make students resilient, it is important for them to feel loved and supported. Therefore, disciplinary measures must be constructive rather than embarrassing. We also need to cultivate their perseverance. How can we instill resilience in them? I believe it can be achieved through positive thinking and constructive comments. I will also prepare cookies as a reward, whether for overcoming failure or looking ahead to future success and remind them mistakes are chances to learn.

Ms. Yeung Yin Hing I believe the balance lies in the mutual trust between teachers and students. With this trust, students can have faith in teachers to uphold the values they cherish. In essence, love and truth must go hand in hand.

5B Chung Cheuk Wing It is important to approach discipline with understanding and focus on positive reinforcement rather than punishment. We should remind students when they violate the school rules for the first time. Guiding students in a more lenient way, rather than imposing harsh consequences, helps foster a supportive environment that cares for their overall well-being. In addition, flexibility is essential. We should consider extenuating circumstances and provide alternative consequences for students.

What words of encouragement would you like to give to the current prefect team?

Ms. Co Co Cheung It is more important to do right things than do things right.

Ms. Yeung Yin Hing Give them the Chinese character "澄", representing clarity and purity of heart, which symbolizes the perseverance of holding onto correct beliefs. This inner clarity serves as the driving force in everything they do, but not to conform to the trends of the world or go with the flow. This steadfast attitude is crucial because the spirit and ethos of ILC are like layers upon layers, built and accumulated by generations. However, a moment of laxity can lead to its downfall.

5B Chung Cheuk Wing To create an environment where our students can thrive academically, socially, and emotionally while enforcement of rules is necessary to exist, the key is to approach discipline with understanding. Always strive to find the right balance between necessary structure and compassionate support. Teamwork is the key.



Contributions

Ecological and Cultural Education Director

Mr. Shum Ting Wing Graduated in 2004 (S.5) and 2006 (S.7)

Currently working in environmental education and serving as the Director of Conservation in an organization I co-founded. (https://www.owlhk.org/zh/index)

In 2016, my two university friends and I saw that the development of environmental education in Hong Kong was slow, that the public, especially students, had lost touch with nature, and there was a lack of a professional environmental education organization to promote it. Therefore, we founded Outdoor Wildlife Learning Hong Kong (OWLHK), which is dedicated to leading more people to learn about the plants and trees around them, as well as appreciating and protecting nature, through innovative, interactive and highly effective environmental education activities.

To me, the greatest sense of success and satisfaction is to see the change in the participants' attitude towards nature after participating in outdoor activities. Many city-dwellers may have an inexplicable resistance to nature before joining the activities, or even a fear of certain creatures, which is mostly due to the lack of knowledge and contact with nature since they were young, as they have not cultivated a proper attitude towards nature. Therefore, to see the participants change their minds or even admire creatures of nature after the activities is a great affirmation of my work and that of the team.



I can say that my years at ILC were instrumental in helping me to define my future career path. This may sound cliché, but after working for more than a decade, I realize that I was very lucky, because it is not easy to identify one's own aspirations in secondary school. At least not many of my friends who are involved in the field of environmental education and childcare had a clear idea of what they would like to do in the future during secondary school.

I remember that when I joined the Geography Club in S.2, I had the opportunity to get in touch with nature through hiking activities after school. When I was in S.3, Ms. Leung Ka Yi recommended me to participate in a district bird-watching competition. This experience made me realize for the first time that Hong Kong has such a rich variety of bird species. At the same time, I lamented that there are very few people who are aware of this fact and who would be similarly amazed. Therefore, I have decided that I would like to devote myself to the work of environmental conservation and education, so that I can personally protect my own natural environment, and to inspire more people to cherish and care for the natural world.

I wish my brothers and sisters at ILC the courage to step out and explore, to find and embrace the unique beauty in life!










Campus Minister


